Mahmoud also studied music composition with professional composers such, as Houtaf Khoury (Lebanon), Julian Broughton (London) Neje Kuhar (Vienna), Mark Zaleski (USA), David Gregory (USA), Steven Khiby (USA), and Rick McLaughlin (USA), and also studied the guitar as a master's professional degree with Pedro Lopez de La Osa (Spain), who is considered one of the most important guitar teachers in the world.
